



## This Supercharged Porsche 928 Race Car Makes an Incredible 1113 HP

It also makes one hell of a noise.

When you think of Porsche race cars, the 928 isn't exactly the first car that comes to mind. It's big and heavy, more suited to grand touring duty than track work. But this 928 is different.

Built by Carl Fausett of [928 Motorsports](#), this car was designed to go racing, and packs a 6.57-liter V-8 making 1113 horsepower and 956 lb-ft. According to [Engine Swap Depot](#), it has forged pistons, ported heads, steel valves, and custom camshafts. Boost comes courtesy of a V7 Ysi supercharger. Power gets to the rear wheels via a lightweight torque tube and a rear-mounted Tremec TR6060 six-speed manual transmission.

The car has previously competed in land speed events and the Pikes Peak International Hill Climb. As you can hear from the video above, it sounds fantastic. Other modifications include a full roll cage, widebody fenders, and a stripped interior. The front body panels have been removed, with the frame modified to accept a single clamshell piece for easy removal. As far as 928s go, it's one serious build. We're curious to see which event Fausett brings it to next.
