

Storing a 928

Whether it's for Winter or for some other reason, you may need to store your 928 for several months.

Follow these few steps as you put it away and it will not only start right up upon your return, but it'll save you a lot of headaches and repair costs.

Wash the car and dry it. Make sure it is completely dry before storing.

Put "Stabil" in the fuel system and drive the car for at least 10 minutes before shutting it off.

Check your antifreeze levels in the cooling system and windshield washer system. These provide both anti-corrosion protection and anti-freeze Protection, so keep them up.

Disconnect the battery, or purchase and use a battery maintenance device (not a battery charger, they are different)

Put the car up on 4 jack stands so the tires are not touching the ground. Alternatively, you can place each of the tires in a concave tire cradle.

Leave the car in neutral, Park if its is an automatic. Do not set the Parking Brake.

Cover the car with a quality car cover and park it indoors. A heated garage is not necessary, but a low-humidity location is. If it will be humid in the spot you have chosen to park the car, consider running a dehumidifier near the car.

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
